GET READY FOR YOUR



Once you're all signed up, here's what happens next...

- We calculate how much solar energy you need based on your historical electricity usage.
- You'll receive an email to set up your MySolar Account, where you can update contact and account information, access all your documents like Community Solar Savings Statements, and see your monthly savings and environmental impact.

Once the solar farm is built and generating electricity...

*If your farm is already generating credits, you'll skip straight to the second bullet point!

- We'll send you an email notifying you that your solar farm is live and operational.
- Community Solar Credits (CSCs) will be shown on your next utility bill, reducing its total cost by the amount of CSCs generated by your community solar share.
- Since your state supports consolidated billing, you'll receive a Savings Statement from us rather than an invoice because your utility handles that you get a discount on CSCs.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Community solar sounds too good to be true...what's the catch?

There is no catch! Community solar is a state-regulated program in over 20 states and there are projects in over 41 states. Renewable energy is cheaper than fossil fuels, so companies like Neighborhood Sun increase access to shared renewables by helping residents subscribe to a community solar farm in their area. Since 2018, Neighborhood Sun has managed over nearly 800 Million kWh of clean energy and passed on more than \$8 Million on their electricity costs to 30,000+ community solar subscribers.

Does community solar cost me anything?

Nope! There is NO cost to join or cancel, NO equipment to install or maintain, and NO rate hikes. If fact, you're guaranteed to SAVE money on energy costs every month just by powering your house or apartment with community solar. You will still pay your current utility provider for the electricity you use, but now it will come from a cheaper and cleaner energy source that doesn't harm you or your environment.

How will community solar credits be reflected on my utility bill?

Once your community solar farm is generating power, your electric utility bill will show a credit each month. This credited amount represents the energy you're getting from your solar share, and it typically covers about 90% of your electricity usage. Starting in 2025, New Jersey supports consolidated billing for community solar subscribers. That means you will not need to make a separate payment to Neighborhood Sun to receive your community solar credits at a discount. Different utilities use different terms to describe the credits you get from community solar. Look under the "This Month's Charges and Credits" section or "CDG Credit Summary" on your utility bill to see a line item labeled as either "Community Solar Credits" or "CDG Credits," depending on your utility. This will indicate the amount of discounted savings you received from the energy generated by your share of the solar farm for that specific production period. Please note that the "Subscriber Fee" is not an additional fee. It reflects the value of the solar credits after your discount has been applied. You can find a sample bill from your utility on our <u>Support page</u> at neighborhoodsun.solar/support . Although you may see something labeled as an invoice or bill in certain parts of the <u>MySolar portal</u>, because your state supports consolidated billing, you never owe Neighborhood Sun any money or form of payment. What might appear to be an invoice is actually a summary of your savings through your monthly Community Solar Savings Statement.

What are the benefits of community solar?

There are so many incredible benefits to community solar! You're saving money on energy costs each month while also helping to reduce tons of harmful pollutants from entering our atmosphere by displacing fossil fuels from our electric grid. Plus, by getting your solar energy locally, you're supporting local jobs and fostering a community that is making clean energy more accessible and affordable to everyone--not just the select few. Community solar is a win-win-win all around!

How to Use MySolar Pt. 1

What Is MySolar?

MySolar is your one-stop-shop for all your community solar subscription details, including your contact and account information, **Community Solar Savings Statements**, and your estimated monthly savings, as well as prevented carbon emissions. You can also upload your sample utility bill through **MySolar** to help us make the most accurate estimation of your electricity needs.

Accessing MySolar

You can access <u>MySolar</u> by visiting <u>https://ns.solarforall.io/login.cfm.</u> Your Username is the email address you provided during sign-up, and your password is to be set up via the "*Congratulations*" email you received the same day you completed your enrollment with Neighborhood Sun.

Please note that the link to set up your MySolar password would have expired two weeks after sending it. If you did not create a password for MySolar, please email our support team at <u>hello@neighborhoodsun.solar</u> to request a new MySolar login.

At a Glance

On the front page of the MySolar portal, you can see the positive impact of your community solar subscription, both for you and the planet, including the amount of carbon emissions prevented by your decision to support community solar, as well as the total amount of savings from your last utility bill, and estimated savings since joining our solar community. On the right-hand side of the front page, you'll see options to update your account details.

Managing Your Account


You can view and download your Community Solar Savings Statements by clicking the "Billing" tab once you're in the *Manage My Account* view of your MySolar portal. From here, you can see your past Community Solar Savings Statements to see how much you're saving on each monthly electricity bill from your utility. Next to each Community Solar Savings Statement, you can click the *View* button to open your invoice in a separate window from which you can download and save individual invoices.
